1. Santa Gloria Sauvignon Blanc	<i>Central Valley</i>	Chile	£19.95
A supple, well-rounded and elegantly structured wine, overlaid with notes of peach and pineapple aromas and flavours.			
2. Santa Gloria Chardonnay	<i>Central Valley</i>	Chile	£19.95
Ripe, rich and concentrated with layers of pear, melon and ripe figs. This fine Chardonnay has subtle aromas that linger on.			
3. Damina Pinot Grigio	<i>Veneto</i>	Italy	£20.95
Straw yellow colour, fresh and crisp with apple, pear and peach flavours.			
4. Arnegui Rioja Viura White	<i>Rioja</i>	Spain	£22.95
This wine holds a bouquet of white flowers, tangerines, banana, orange peel and other citrus fruits with a subtle hint of passion fruit. On the palate, it is clean and silky with an ample aftertaste.			
5. Fairhall Cliffs Sauvignon Blanc	<i>Marlborough</i>	New Zealand	£25.95
This is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshingly dry finish. Zesty fruit on the palate with lots of lime and a nettly herbaceousness.			
6. Curious Kiwi Gewurztraminer	<i>Marlborough</i>	New Zealand	£26.95
Brilliant straw colour. The aroma of ripe banana, lychee with hints of rose and honey, the bright taste of exotic fruits and spicy touches in a refreshing aftertaste.			
7. Fantini Trebbiano d'Abruzzo	<i>Abruzzo</i>	Italy	£28.95
Deep, bright, straw yellow. Medium bodied, quite intense and persistent, fruity and floral with aromas of peach and orange blossom. Full-bodied, quite well-balanced, intense and persistent.			
8. Chateau Bauduc Sauvignon Blanc	<i>Bordeaux</i>	France	£32.95
Listed in Rick Stein's and Gordon Ramsay's Michelin star restaurants for over 20 years. Bright but gentle, crisp and modern but not pithy, just fresh with a lemon, elderflower and yellow nectarine taste. A class act.

9. Feather Falls Rose	<i>California</i>	USA	£20.95
A youthful wine with aromas of fresh cherries and watermelon. On the palate, flavours of juicy ripe strawberries and sweet candy are incredibly sumptuous and ever so moreish.			
10. Elicio Rose IGP Mediterranean		France	£25.95
Its bright pink colour and nose packed with fresh raspberry and heady flowers lead to a juicy palate that echoes the aromas revealed by the vibrant nose, then throws in tropical and mineral tones to ride out the finish with you.

11. Santa Gloria Merlot	<i>Central Valley</i>	Chile	£19.95
Gorgeous deep colour and a bright, generous nose of forest berries, plum and sweet spice. Medium-weight, soft palate with barely-there tannins and approachable flavours of fruitcake, mint and black olive. Super easy to drink – a lovely wine.			
12. Santa Gloria Cabernet Sauvignon	<i>Mendoza</i>	Chile	£19.95
Concentrated flavours of blackberries and ripe plums with a firm structure and fine oak overtones. This is an elegant, full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon that offers a complex varietal character.			
13. Novecento Malbec	<i>Central Valley</i>	Argentina	£22.95
A young, fruity malbec of attractive red colour, vivacious and with ruby glints. Red and black fruit, such as plum and blackberry, and spices in the complex background make this varietal alive. Velvety with tons of fruit on the palate.			
14. Dry River Shiraz		Australia	£23.95
This Shiraz displays a nose of smoky rich fruits with a touch of mint. Smooth and rich on the palate with spicy flavours of luscious dark berry fruits. The balanced tannins help to deliver a tremendously concentrated finish.			
15. Arnegui Rioja Crianza	<i>Rioja</i>	Spain	£26.95
Aromas of dried fruit and ripe blackberries, leather notes and nuances of vanilla. On the palate, the wine is very soft and round, ripe with a silky texture and subtle herbal undertones. The wine has a long-lasting, warming finish.			
16. Zabu Syrah Terre Siciliane		Italy	£28.95
This wine features a clear, red ruby hue with crimson highlights. Red fruit aromas, fresh with balsamic hints. On the palate it is full-bodied with vivid tannins and a fresh ending.			
17. Lama di Pietra Nero di Trioia	<i>Puglia</i>	Italy	£29.95
Red fruit aromas of mulberry and cherry give way to a soft palate with delicate tannins. Persistent, full-bodied and elegant, this Nero di Trioia is perfectly balanced.			
18. Domaine Vaux St. George Pinot Noir	<i>Loire Valley</i>	France	£32.95
This wine is unoaked and delightfully fresh. Aromas are of ripe, almost sweet, berry fruit and floral notes. Juicy strawberry flavours, refreshing acidity and the gentlest of tannins come together in this great value cool-climate Pinot Noir.			

19. Gran Allegranza Monastrell	<i>Alicante</i>	Spain	£32.95
Aromas of blackberries, ripe juicy dark cherries and gentle notes of wild herbs balance o^ with dark chocolate. On the palate the wine is rich and juicy with good concentration between mature fruits and rich dark chocolate with a natural sweetness and gentle tannins that lay smooth over the palate.
